The girls are expected to come into the classroom and put away their own book bags, snack bags and coats on their peg. This makes them more independent but still within the familiar surroundings and routines of the Reception class.

In the last half term, the Reception girls will line up at the kitchen serving area at lunchtime and choose their own lunch. They are supported in this by the staff on duty. Special attention is given to the pupils with allergies and plated food.

During the last term in Reception, girls will go out to play on the main playground more regularly.

On the June Induction morning the Reception girls spend a morning with their new Year 1 teacher and under normal circumstances also meet any new girls who will be joining the class in September. Parents are informed by email about the morning and told who will be teaching Year 1 in September. On the induction morning, the Head of Prep and Prep SLT meet with new parents to explain the beginning of term and answer any questions.
