



<u>Checklist for your daughter's first day at Streatham & Clapham High School</u> <u>6th September 2023 (IT Induction morning 5th September)</u>

Start time: Girls should come via the Girls' Entrance gate (as Induction Day). The gate will be signposted on the morning. Please go through to the Madeleine Dring Hall at 8.15 am, where girls will be met. Tea and coffee will be provided for parents should they want it.

- End of School: 3.55 pm.
- Uniform: Please ensure that it is labelled, including shoes and PE kit (see Parent Handbook for correct uniform). Only one stud earring can be worn in each ear. A watch may also be worn, and a discreet necklace with religious significance. No other jewellery, make up or false nails are permissible.
- Morning snack: Girls may purchase items at break time or bring in their own nut-free snack.
- **Bottle of water:** This should be clearly labelled with your child's name; please try to avoid single-usage plastic bottles.
- **PE bag:** Your daughter will have PE during her first week but will be given her timetable on the first day. On PE days, she will need to bring her full PE kit. Please ensure that the bag is fitted with a padlock.
- Mobile phone locker: Girls should have a small padlock for this facility.
- **Parking:** We should like to remind parents and girls of our commitment to being good neighbours and citizens. If at all possible we encourage car sharing. If you are collecting your daughter by private car, please remember to observe all road traffic markings, including double yellow and zig-zag lines which prohibit parking or stopping at all times of day. We ask you to remember to keep any noise to a minimum and only run the engine of your vehicle when necessary.
- **Timetables and Induction Materials:** Girls will be given their timetables, and any induction materials.
- Lunch: For the first few days, your daughter will be guided through the lunch process at an earlier time than normal. Any dietary requirements that have been recorded on the online Medical Questionnaire will be catered for.
- **Homework:** No homework will be set for the first three weeks in order to ensure a smooth transition.
